- New Business
 - Update on the City of San Diego/City Lakes Fiscal Year 2024/2025 Budget. As you noted in the email that was sent out last week, the County stepped up and provided the \$59K to the City Lakes/Public Utilities Department to keep the lakes open and available on the same current schedule. County Supervisor, Joel Anderson supported this and spearheaded the transfer of money to the City. Thank you to everyone who participated in our letter writing campaign and got involved to protect our lakes. SD Bassmasters has created a Political Action Committee and they will be meeting soon to discuss what projects and lobbying we want to take on next. If you are interested in becoming involved in this Committee, please contact Dave Seeberg.
 - DFG is hosting their annual "Jamboree" where all of the tournament series select their dates for their 2025 Tournaments. The date for this event is scheduled for Thursday July 25, 2024. We need a representative from the council to attend and assist with selecting our dates.
